Geographica Slovenica 19 prinaša drugi del referatov udeležencev blejskega posvetovanja: Pokrajinski učinki človekovih dejavnosti na življenjsko okolje. Pričajočih 17 prispevkov avtorjev iz SR Slovenije in tujine vsebinsko zaokroža tematiko tega odmevnega posvetovanja. Prevladujejo prispevki geografov. Konkretno ugotovitve avtorjev, ki temelje na rezultatih empiričnih raziskovanj in so obohatene z najnovejšimi teoretičnimi in metodološkimi pristopi bodo zagotovo pomemben mejnik pri bodočih prizadevanjih geografske stROKE, v okviru vse intenzivnejšega raziskovanja tako kompleksne prostorske problematike kot je degradacija življenjskega okolja. Prispevki z omenjeno tematiko neposredno in posredno zadevajo odnos med naravo in človekom oziroma družbo.
