GEOGRAFSKE KONFERENCE**

ORGANIZATION

The second Slovenian-Hungarian Geographical Conference in Ljubljana, April 1-3, 1993, is organized by The Anton Melik Institute of Geography ZRC SAZU, the Association of Geographical Societies of Slovenia and in cooperation with the Institute of Geography of the University and the Department of Geography, Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana.

On April 1, after the plenary session, the communications were presented in the session of the application of geographic information system in geography, and in the session for the border areas with mixed Slovenian and Hungarian population. In the following day participants were divided in the session for border areas and the session for applied geocology. Afternoon on April 2, the excursion in the Slovenian NW region Gorenjsko followed, guided by M. Sc. Milan Orožen Adamič. On April 3, the excursion to NO Slovenia (Prekmurje) and the near Hungarian border areas in the basin of the Raba guided by Ludvik Olas ended the Conference.

The organized committee with members Drago Perko, Peter Repolusk and Mauro Hrvatin was chaired by Karel Natek.

The Conference was financially supported by Ministry of Science and Technology of the Republic Slovenia.
